LONDON (Reuters) - Britain's supreme court on Monday voted 6-0 to throw out Prime Minister Theresa May's appeal seeking to overturn a ruling by the country's top court that allowed parliament to seize control of Brexit.

The procedure will trigger a 14-day countdown to Britain's scheduled departure from the European Union on March 29. Parliament is due to hold a marathon four-day debate from Tuesday on the wording of an EU divorce deal, and has passed a law requiring the government to publish Brexit negotiating papers by Monday. However, Speaker John Bercow last week told lawmakers the government had missed this deadline and they would hold a series of votes on Tuesday and Wednesday on different amendments to rule out a no-deal Brexit. Parliament passed a law last week giving itself control over what happens during the Brexit process - including whether it leaves the EU without an agreement. Supreme Court judges ruled that the government must ask the EU to extend the Article 50 negotiating period by at least three months if they have not secured a deal by March 29, to help avoid a no-deal Brexit. May's attorney general, Geoffrey Cox, argued that the ruling would force Britain to choose between leaving without a deal or remaining in the EU. The court rejected those arguments and said parliament's decision to take control over the Brexit process reflected a greater respect for the law than in the government's own interpretation. "In a democratic society, the supreme law of the land is Parliament," Britain's Supreme Court said in a statement. "In a representative democracy, the supreme law of the land is the people. Parliament is sovereign. It is the people that we represent. The powers of government are dependent on the consent of the governed." The decision is the latest in a series of defeats for May's senior ministers, who argue the ruling was not justified because c6a93da74d
